Club/Interest Group Guidelines

Membership: Membership in a Club/Interest Group shall be open to all Association members in good standing. Each group will have a membership roster that will need to be updated on a regular basis and available to Village at Vistancia Community Management upon request. Infractions to the Community Rules, Regulations and Governing Documents within the group may result in the suspension of privileges.

Equal Opportunity: Clubs/Interest Groups are recognized and approved by Village at Vistancia Community Management to provide an opportunity for all association members to pursue common interests in hobbies, recreational, social and cultural endeavors without discriminating as to race, religion, color, ethnic culture or national heritage. The facilities are for the exclusive use of members and their guests as determined in the Community Rules, Regulations and Governing Documents.

Leadership: Each Club/Interest Group must have one designated member who is responsible for communication within the group and with Village at Vistancia Community Management. During use of Association facilities or scheduled meetings, this member will act as a monitor to ensure Association policies and procedures are followed as outlined in the Community Rules.

Meeting Room Space: Clubs/Interest Groups are allowed one rental space per month (up to 3 hours), upon written request made to the Village at Vistancia Lifestyle Assistant. As space allows, Clubs/Interest Groups are provided with a regular meeting space without charge. All group scheduled activities must be during normal facility hours. Room availability is conditional on community events, meetings and activities of the Association. All room set-up and tear down is the responsibility of the group. This includes clean-up of the room due to food, beverages and other items.

HOA Administrative and Technical Support: The Lifestyle Assistant can assist Clubs/Interest Groups with limited technical assistance such as group communications, save the dates and calendar/eNews reminders.

Alcohol Policy: As a recognized Club/Interest Group, your group qualifies for an exception as outlined in the Alcohol Policy in the Community Rules, Regulations and Governing Documents. The group leader must identify the Club/Interest Group as a BYOB event on the application. If the leader does not identify as BYOB but later wishes to have BYOB at a meeting, they must first notify the Lifestyle Assistant to receive approval.

Financial Gain: Clubs/Interest Groups are not allowed to use the Community Center for personal or financial gain. (Examples are cooking parties, candle parties, jewelry parties or other similar activities, in which members of the group can earn monies or gifts).
